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COMMON MYTHS ABOUT WET BASEMENTS

1. You can waterproof your basement by applying products to inside of basement wall, either paint, hydronic cement, or other products.
2. Raising the grade around your house will dry up your basement.
3. Water coming up through floor means a high water table.
4. Fixing a crack in a wall, or floor, will keep water out of basement.
5. Underground downspout drains are rarely a problem.
6. "Aftermarket" waterproofing systems are approved by building codes.
7. Bad weeping tiles are a major cause of basement seepage.
8. Gutter covers are a great investment.
9. Window well covers prevent basement seepage.
10. Having a handyman install gutters is a great option.
